But it wasn't until 25 years later that they were finally built. Today, the Ancient Spanish Monastery is used by the parish church of St. Bernard de Clairvaux, an active and growing congregation in Southeast Florida. Services are held at the church on Sundays and weekdays but visors are welcome to tour the field most days between 10 A.M and 4.30pm P.M. Spend the day watching the park's incredible water show, or get a little more hands on by experiencing one of their seven animal encounters, including, swimming with dolphins, being a trainer for the day, or trekking through lively coral reefs. The Seaquarium is the perfect family activity. 12 of the 20 dbvirago/getty Sail by some of the most luxurious properties in all of Miami in a millionaire's line of sea voyages. On land, Row is considered a stretch of Collins Avenue from 41st Street to 62nd Street, but not many of these mega-mansions can be seen from the side of the road. A cruise, on the other hand makes the scenery much more accessible. Departures are usually on the clock and most tours leave near Bayside Marketplace. Expect to pay anywhere between \$25-\$35 for a 90-minute guided tour. Continue to 13 of the 20 below. 13 of 20 ArendTrent/getty Built in the early 1930s, Stiltsville is one of Miami's special experiences that tourists crave. The collection of houses is built using wood and a reinforced concrete stilt that sits about ten feet above the shallows of Biscayne Bay. The houses are located on the sandbank about a mile south of Cape Florida. While it is not entirely agreed why these houses were built like them, most historians would agree that the first Stiltsville house, built by crayfish fisherman Eddie Walker, was used to facilitate gambling towards the end of the prohibition era. Currently, there are seven homes in Stiltsville and are under the care of the Biscayne National Park Service, although each homeowner is tasked with maintaining the property. 14 of 20 TripSavvy/Taylor McIntyre The Miami Beach Botanical Gardens is a 2.6-acre green space right in the middle of the city. They feature many subtropical plants from around the world in addition to many species native to Florida. Admission is free unless there is a special event, and the park is open Tuesday through Sunday 9 A.M. to 5 P.M. 15 of 20 SEASTOCK/Getty Another great way to experience Miami Beach is by speedboat tour. No one said Miami Vice as a 50mph catamaran went up around Biscayne Bay. Thriller Speedboat Adventures has been running tours for over 10 years and offers stiltsville tours as well. Speedboat tours are usually narrated and can last anywhere from 45 minutes to an hour and a half. Expect to pay about \$40 per person. 16 out of 20 Take a break from tanning on the beach and experience Miami's party side at one of South Beach's many daily pool parties. Most hotels in the area, such as Dream South Beach, Mondrian South Beach and Cleavelander, open their pools to the public and offer some amazing parties. Hope to find a DJ, a selection of open bars, and lots of handsome people. Admission can cost up to \$30 plus drinks so be sure to find out what's included before heading inside.
